

New E-Learning Training Offerings



At Automation College, our primary instruction model joins expert instructors and students together in a laboratory environment. There, students receive hands-on experience through exercises that follow short lectures. Where it has not been convenient for customers to take this training at one of many training centers around the world, we send instructors and equipment for on-site training at a customer location, or nearby.

Recently, customers have explained that they need more opportunities for remote and just-in-time training. Early in 2010 we announced the availability of five additional types of e-Learning training.

- **Computer-Based Training:** These interactive courses are purchased as CDs or DVDs that play on your personal computer. The courses focus on TPS implementation, operations, and overview, and include refresher training.
- **Recorded Training:** These 1-2 hour modules address Experion release differences, and allow your employees who have completed instructor-led installation and implementation courses to learn “what’s new” in each new release of Experion . . . without having to repeat the full class. Like the e-Learning options that follow, recorded training playback requires access to the Internet.
- **Live Webinars:** These are remote sessions in which an instructor and small groups of students are involved real time. Conducted through a simultaneous telephone conference call and a PC-based meeting connection, these allow students to view the instructor’s computer. Webinars address fundamental skills, and can be arranged to fit a customer’s calendar when a pre-scheduled session is not convenient.
- **Virtual Training:** These are the remote versions of our complete, classroom-based courses. They “blend” real-time sessions with the instructor, electronic documentation, recorded lectures and demonstration videos *with the same labs offered at our in-center classes*. But students complete these labs remotely by accessing our bank of VMWare based servers. So, for the first time ever, without any travel,

students can complete many of our key foundation courses:

- **Asynchronous Training:** Asynchronous Training courses contain the same content as conventional in-center courses, but instead of traveling to a center, students attend from their own work or home locations. With 24-hour access to all course content for a specified period of time, students progress at their own pace and on their own schedule.
